This vision is lived out through community and global ministries such as donating time and talents to feed and clothe the hungry (Sharing and Caring, One Hopeful Place, Children in Crisis, Fresh Start), provide beds for children (Bed4Me), build houses for struggling families (Porch de Salomon Guatemala), give hope to the sick and lonely (prayer pillows), and giving of monetary donations to local and global areas of need as well as ministering to our brothers and sisters within our congregation.

The community immediately surrounding the church is low income and racially diverse. The church addresses emerging needs in the community by offering meeting space for aid groups in the large campus buildings (AA, NA, Legal Aid), by contributing monetary donations to the food bank that adjoins the church property, and by hosting a neighborhood trunk or treat event for children.
