How would you describe the congregation's/organization's specific vision for ministry? How will this vision impact the community? Is the congregation part of a ministry vision or program?

We live out our vision of growing to know God and living to show God by making disciples who are ready to go out into today's world and be active.

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We grow as disciples through several Christian Education offerings from Sunday school classes, intergenerational learning opportunities, and weekly Bible studies. Each of these offerings help us to deepen our spiritual relationship with God through His Word and be more connected together as Christians in today's world. We also take these opportunities to look at what Jesus addressed in His communities through His actions and how we can do similar works today. We fulfill our mission of living to show God by utilizing our Spiritual Gifts and taking actions that range from a simple greeting to a community event. Our Evangelism team encourages the congregation to invite people to Worship and events held on our campus. We live to show God by taking care of not only the people in our community but by taking care of all that God has given us including our beautiful campus which is a block from the Atlantic Ocean.

What is the nature and context of the community in which your congregation lives out its mission/vision? How will you address the emerging needs that are impacting your community?

During the pandemic almost all of our hands-on activities were halted, but we are blessed with a congregation that was able to give financially during these times. Post-pandemic our committees are active, functioning and re-engaging our partnerships and our community to make sure that we are addressing current and emerging needs. Some of our local partners include:

- Halifax Urban Ministry - feeding of the homeless
- Family Renew Community - transitional housing for homeless families with children
- Pace Center for Girls - schooling and mentoring for girls
- Rose Marie Bryon Children's Center – after school program
- Habitat for Humanity - making plans to potentially sponsor another house
- Presbyterian Counseling Center – Counseling in a spirit of pastoral care with an office located on our campus. We also reach out to the community with our summer children's music camp (instead of VBS). Backyard Bible gatherings for all youth and parents which provides additional opportunities for the youth to invite friends. AMSDEN Academy talks with speakers who highlight needs such as health topics, estate planning, etc. with a theological element. Supporting local schools especially during

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Christmas to provide gifts for the underprivileged. We actively use our Facebook page to share invites and promote participation in these events.

How will this call help complement the responsibilities of other staff/volunteer positions, and the life of the congregation/organization, so that you may accomplish your short and long-term goals for ministry?

A Pastor that can continue to motivate and encourage us to think outside of our comfort zones to reach our community for Christ is our goal. Our Interim Pastor has done great work in getting the committees back on their feet and focused on functioning as an extension of the Session. We desire a Pastor who is actively involved with each committee and its purpose and seeks to encourage each committee on how best to carry out their vision and function. One idea that the congregation has proposed, and committees are evaluating, is partnering with other local churches for community events or youth activities. We desire a Pastor who can foster or enhance relationships with other area churches to build bridges in a way that impacts our Ormond Beach community. We also cannot lose sight of our existing congregation and its importance. Our congregation is predominantly elderly and enjoys our traditional worship, therefore we are seeking a Pastor that can be innovative in maintaining and enhancing this traditional style of worship while also seeking opportunities to grow our youth and younger adults.

A Pastor that can help us to understand how to live a Christ-like life in today's world. Helping us to understand how we each contribute as a member ministering to one another within this congregation and motivating us in mission towards the larger community to be the Hands of God. Overall we are looking for a Pastor that can encourage, motivate, and challenge us to fulfill our goals and live into our mission while providing a sense of welcome, comfort and community in today's world.
