We are a church that seeks to nurture our congregation and serve our community as the hands and feet of Christ. We have several ministry goals and activities that reflect our vision, such as:

• Backpack Blessings: We partner with a local elementary school to provide food and snacks for children in need. Every week, we fill backpacks with nutritious items for them to have over the weekend. Backpacks are returned on Monday to be restocked by us.

•The Swails Lot: We have a piece of land that is currently underutilized. We want to transform it into a user-friendly and accessible space for the church and the community. We envision it as a place for recreation, fellowship, and outreach.

•The Williamsburg Kindergarten and Preschool: We are proud to host this school, which has been serving the children and families of our area for 59 years. We want to be more supportive and intentional about reaching out to these families. We believe that our vision will have a positive impact on our community. We strive to work with and for those who are in need, and to foster a loving relationship with our brothers and sisters in Christ.

What is the nature and context of the community in which your congregation lives out its mission/vision? How will you address the emerging needs that are impacting your community?

Williamsburg Presbyterian Church, a cornerstone of faith in Kingstree, SC, sits in Williamsburg County, known for its recreational allure. Kingstree, labeled "Sportsman's Paradise" and "Marked for Excellence," is one of SC's oldest settlements, with 3,200 town residents and 30,500 countywide. The church impacts 15,000 within a 5-mile radius, with 37.4% unchurched, offering outreach opportunities. Proximity to urban centers creates diverse commuting patterns for working families.

Post-pandemic, Kingstree saw real estate growth, attracting commuters and remote workers. Though long-term trends show a slight decline, the past year witnessed growth, creating outreach opportunities. Family homes dominate (53%), fostering a stable community with a high ownership rate.

In a lower-income context, with an average household income of \$40,000 and 28% facing poverty, the church serves as an outreach hub. Demographics mirror some other southern, rural counties, with 68% African Americans and 26% Caucasian residents.

Educationally, Kingstree hosts institutions like Williamsburg Technical College and Williamsburg Academy as well as a robust public school system.
