It is our heart's desire to serve God in and through our church. We seek to meet the needs of our members and to extend our message of love, justice, mercy, and hope to those in our greater community. We look to God to provide us a pastoral leader who can empower and guide us to be God's people in Taylor County. Anticipated tasks include, but are not limited to, leading services with bible-based sermons, pastoral care through visitation and calling members, leading fellowship activities such as Wednesday night suppers, overseeing administrative functions of the church office and staff, and with the Session developing and championing a vision for FPC-Perry which supports goals to sustain the church's ministry over the next several years. It is expected the pastor will have a five-day work week, with flexibility as necessary to meet the needs of both the congregation and pastor.

The mission of God in Christ gives shape and substance to the life and work of FPC-Perry. In Christ, the church participates in God's transformation of creation and humanity by proclaiming to all people the good news of God's love, offering the grace of God at font and table, & calling all to discipleship in Christ. Human beings have no higher goal in life than to glorify & enjoy God now & forever, living in covenant fellowship with God & participating in His mission.

What is the nature and context of the community in which your congregation lives out its mission/vision? How will you address the emerging needs that are impacting your community?

FPC-Perry is located at 310 Plantation Road and serves all of Taylor County, which includes the coastal communities of Steinhatchee and Keaton Beach. The population of the county is approximately 21,000. There are more than 75 churches located in Taylor County, most serving Baptist congregations. We endeavor to participate in ecumenical programs with the Episcopal Church, Roman Catholic Church, and First Methodist Church for youth group events and vacation bible school. Additionally, we partner with many other churches for community outreach programs including food pantries, Fields of Faith, Habitat for Humanity, Trunk or Treat, and Operation Christmas Child. As the intersection of the Florida hurricane evacuation route, we partner with law enforcement, emergency management, and the American Red Cross to provide food and lodging to those fleeing harm's way. We also assist with crisis intervention for transients and locals by supporting the Refuge House and assisting with short-term financial needs.

FPC-Perry has a rich ministerial history over the past 120 years. We have weathered many storms in the past, the present, and will do in the future.
