Buckingham Presbyterian Church's vision for ministry is centered largely on activities that assist "the least of these" (Matthew 25:40). Generous giving of money, time, talent and requested "stuff" and sharing of building space helps support national Presbyterian and local Peace River Presbytery projects, local help groups, and students at our local "adopted" school (Tice Elementary). Our impact on the community does not come close to meeting all the needs, but we do our share. Buckingham Presbyterian Church is a community of Christians who, despite individual challenges, gather to worship God and to share His Love in practical ways using our individual gifts, abilities and interests. Fellowship activities are a strength. Giving of money (donated and raised) and necessities are a strong second including the thousands of items created by Stitch 'n' Stuff each year. Meals, toys, and clothing are collected throughout the year to support an elementary school in our area. Many are still able to serve physically in helping others, but all of us of whatever age pray. We are developing our online presence, share our facilities, partner now and again with other local groups, participate in regular Bible Study groups, and hunger to learn to become better evangelists.

Our BPC community is located within the Buckingham Rural Preserve. Over the years, the surrounding area has changed from being a mostly agricultural area with a smaller population that has evolved, grown, and become more diverse. With these changes comes the opportunity to use our gifts and abilities to explore and reach out to those without a church home.
